Educational aims

This Allergy Training Course aims to provide a comprehensive overview of current state-of-the-art methods in preventing and treating food allergy. It seeks to provide training for health care professionals involved in diagnosing and treating those with food allergies to enable them to deliver improved preventive and treatment strategies to the benefit of food allergic patients. It is set in the context of rapid developments in the field, including numerous studies on the importance of early introduction of allergenic foods for the prevention of allergy later in life and on the new treatments going through clinical trials with the prospect of regulatory approved products in the next few years. The Training Course builds on the EAACI Food Allergy Guidelines and the shortly to be finalized Allergen Immunotherapy guidelines.

It will provide:

- An overview on current understanding of the immunobiology of prevention and immunotherapy of food allergy;
- Sessions on the molecules and foods used for prevention and immunotherapy, together with the role of nutrition and the microbiome in prevention;
- Training in the practical aspects of diagnosis of food allergies from taking a clinical history, to interpreting specific IgE results and undertaking oral food challenges;
- Interactive workshops on the practicalities of preventing food allergy at the population level, food avoidance and what to watch out for regarding side-effects during treatment.

The course will provide a forum to meet experts from across Europe, providing opportunities for learning in an interactive manner with the course faculty and attendees.

A notification letter to inform you whether your abstract has been accepted or not will be sent by the middle of July 2017. If your abstract is accepted, you must confirm your participation to this meeting, register and pay before 25 July 2017.
