EAACI Ethics Committee

The Ethics Committee (EC) is a permanent body of EAACI aimed at ensuring high ethical standards in all areas of EAACI activity and beyond as the European reference structure in the field of ethics in allergy and clinical immunology for training and good practice, research and management of allergic diseases, patient information, patient care, and public health issues concerning the field of allergy and clinical immunology. The EC works as an advisory body of the Executive Committee (ExCom). The ExCom makes the decision.

Term of appointment

In accordance to the EAACI bylaws the term of this position will be for two years, with the option for one re-election for a further two years, under the condition of eligibility. Your term will start in September 2020 and end in June 2022. The successful candidates will be elected in line with the EAACI Governance for elections and approved by the Executive Committee. Once a full committee is in place, elections will be held for the position of Ethics Committee Secretary.

We are pleased to announce the appointment of Professor Barbara Rogala as Ethics Committee Chair 2020-2022, approved by the General Assembly on 08 June 2020 during the Digital Congress.

Board Member Composition

The Ethics Committee comprises four EAACI members (including the Chair) and five non-EAACI members. The committee should be balanced by gender, practice, education, research and other endeavours within the fields of Allergology and Clinical Immunology. It is strongly recommended to include people specialised and involved in Bioethics, Legislation, Patient association, Human sciences (Philosophy, Sociology, Psychology, Public Health, etc.).

Application/Election

Please note that candidates must reside in Europe at the time of election. Only the candidacies of applicants who do not have a significant conflict of interest will be validated.

Applications will be evaluated by the EAACI Election Committee. Election of the Ethics Committee members will take place during the Executive Committee meeting held August 2020, by the [Single Transferable Vote](#) system.
