## General Terms & Conditions

### Definitions

Erasmus Conferences & Events S.A. is the registration system provider of the European Academy of Allergy and Clinical Immunology (hereafter referred to as "EAACI") for the FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020, 16 – 17 October 2020. The provider supports the event secretariat and is responsible for registration services and is hereafter referred to as Erasmus Conferences & Events S.A.

### General Terms and Conditions for Registration

These General Terms and Conditions are valid for each attendee registered for the FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020, 16 – 17 October 2020. Any registered person (physician, healthcare professional, student, media representative, speaker, or exhibitor) is considered an attendee. These General Terms and Conditions are also binding for all group registrations.

### FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020 Registration

Only fully completed registration forms will be accepted. The registration will only be confirmed upon receipt of payment in full. If the maximum attendee capacity is reached, EAACI reserves the right to refuse any registration.

To be eligible to register for the FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020, attendees must be at least 18 years old. Attendees may be asked to provide an official identity card stating their age.

The registration fee for regular participants, students, speakers, and media representatives includes access to the entire digital event platform including the scientific sessions, the Exhibition Hall (except lay press) and the e-Abstracts.

To register as a media representative, please refer to the EAACI website <https://www.eaaci.org/eaacimedia.html> Section II - Accreditation, Registration and Access to EAACI Events directly in order to receive a media registration form. Official press credentials need to be submitted to prove the status as media representative. There is no registration fee for accredited media representatives.

### Group Registrations

Registrations for ten (10) or more persons will be handled separately as a group booking. Please note that the General Terms and Conditions stated in this document, are applicable for each participant registered by a group. It is the group contact's responsibility to ensure that each participant is only registered once. Cancellations of duplicated registrations will be handled in accordance with the registration cancellation policy.

### Methods of Payment

Payment is required at the time of registration by Credit card (Visa/Mastercard) in EUR. Attendees should complete the relevant section of the registration form.

### Letter of Confirmation/Payment Receipt

A letter of confirmation/payment receipt will be sent by email once the FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020 Registration Team has received the fully completed registration form and the

related payment.

### **Certificate of Attendance & CME**

A Certificate of Attendance and a Continuing Medical Education (CME) Credit Statement for regular participants will be available after the FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020. Each participant will be tracked during their online participation in order to be able to award CME credits, hence it is important that you allow cookies from your browser. CME credits will be awarded depending on the time spent on EAACI live session programme (industry programme excluded). 60 minutes viewing will be awarded with 1 CME credit. Each medical specialist should claim the recognition of the UEMS/EACME CME credits to his/her own CME National Authority.

### **Registration Category Change**

A handling fee of EUR 20 will be charged for registration type changes. Refund requests will be processed after the FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020 only. They must be made in writing and sent to the FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020 Registration Team by email. Refunds will be credited only to person / entity who / which paid the original registration.

### **Registration Name Change**

A handling fee of EUR 20 will be charged for every name change to an existing FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020 registration. A new registration form for the substitute attendee should be submitted, as well as a proof for the reduced fee if applicable. Name changes will only be accepted until 30 September 2020, clearly indicating the new and old name.

### **Registration Cancellation Policy**

Notification of cancellation must be made in writing and sent to the FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020 Registration Team by email. The notification must include all the relevant information regarding the bank account to which a possible refund may be remitted.

If the written notification of cancellation is received before 14 September 2020, an administration fee of 75% of the paid FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020 fee will be charged. No refunds will be made for cancellations received after this date. Refund requests will be processed after FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020 only. They must be made in writing and sent to the FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020 Registration Team by email no later than 14 days after the FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020. No refund request will be processed after this date. Refund will not be given for unattended events or early termination of attendance. Refunds will be credited only to person / entity who / which paid the original registration. In cases of cancellations due to personal matters, after the cancellation deadline, please consult your personal insurance.

### **Access**

During the registration process, each participant must accept the here outlined General Terms and Conditions in accordance with GDPR to access the digital platform. After online registration, you will receive personal access details to access the FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020 platform. This access details are strictly personal and cannot be given to any other person. We will identify all access details on our platform.

### **Modification of the FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020 Programme**

EAACI reserves the right to modify the programme, which is published as an indication only. No refunds will be granted in case the programme changes (including change of speakers).

### **Cancellation of the FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020**

In the event that the FAAM-EUROBAT Digital 2020 cannot be held or is postponed due to events beyond the control of EAACI (force majeure) or due to events which are not attributable to wrongful intent or gross negligence of EAACI, EAACI cannot be held liable by attendees for any damages or financial losses incurred.
